

Dear friends, colleagues and collaborators of Prof. J. Pozela,

This year Prof. Juras Pozela would be 90 years old. Juras Pozela, who passed away in November 2014, was one of the most outstanding personalities in Lithuanian scientific community. He was a prominent physicist, organizer of science and public man, the founder and also the first and long-time director of the Semiconductor Physics Institute, a leading academic research institution in Lithuania and an important international science centre. Prof. J. Pozela was vice-president and president of the Lithuanian Academy of Sciences for many years, and also the former member of the Parliament of Lithuania. During his entire scientific life he was an active author (and, for some time, editorial board member) of Lithuanian Journal of Physics. The editorial board of LJP decided to pay tribute to Prof. J. Pozela as a physicist by dedicating one issue of the journal in 2015 to his memory. Hereby, we send the e-mails to all his colleagues and collaborators asking to participate in this commemoration by submitting the paper with original scientific results (preferably related to semiconductor physics) to our special issue. The deadline for submission is September 2015. Lithuanian Journal of Physics (<http://www.lmaleidykla.lt/ojs/index.php/physics>; <http://www.itpa.lt/~lfd/Lfz/LFZ.html>) is a peer-reviewed open-access research quarterly, published by the Lithuanian Academy of Sciences. Its impact factor in 2013 was 0.456.
